**14** Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ **On March 9, 2012, Wilmington Broad Market Bond Fund merged into MTB Income Fund in a tax-free exchange under Internal Revenue Code Sec. 368(a). Immediately after the merger, the MTB Funds were rebranded as the Wilmington Funds and the MTB Income Fund was renamed the Wilmington Broad Market Bond Fund.**

**Each share of Wilmington Broad Market Bond Fund - A Shares (CUSIP: 92934T708, Ticker: WBRBX) was exchanged for 1.000932 shares of MTB Income Fund - A Shares (CUSIP: 55376T874, Ticker: AKIRX). The MTB Income Fund - A Shares were renamed the Wilmington Broad Market Bond Fund - A Shares and issued a new CUSIP of 97181C829.**

**Each share of Wilmington Broad Market Bond Fund - Institutional Shares (CUSIP: 92934R603, Ticker: WBRIX) was exchanged for 1.016799 shares of MTB Income Fund - Institutional Shares (CUSIP: 55376T858, Ticker: ARKIX). The MTB Income Fund - Institutional Shares were renamed the Wilmington Broad Market Bond Fund - Institutional Shares and issued a new CUSIP of 97181C811.**

**15** Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ **Each shareholder's aggregate basis in the shares they received in the exchange will equal their aggregate basis in the shares they surrendered.**

**A Shares - The basis of each share received (CUSIP: 97181C829, Ticker: AKIRX) is equal to 99.9069% of the basis of each share surrendered (CUSIP: 92934T708, Ticker: WBRBX).**

**Institutional Shares - The basis of each share received (CUSIP: 97181C811, Ticker: ARKIX) is equal to 98.3479% of the basis of each share surrendered (CUSIP: 92934R603, Ticker: WBRIX).**

**16** Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ **The aggregate basis of the shares received is the same as the aggregate basis of the shares surrendered.**

**A Shares - The net asset value for each share surrendered (CUSIP: 92934T708, Ticker: WBRBX) in the exchange was \$10.200010. The net asset value for each share received (CUSIP: 97181C829, Ticker: AKIRX) in the exchange was \$10.190506.**

**Institutional Shares - The net asset value for each share surrendered (CUSIP: 92934R603, Ticker: WBRIX) in the exchange was \$10.195967. The net asset value for each share received (CUSIP: 97181C811, Ticker: ARKIX) in the exchange was \$10.027510.**
